1. WHAT IS THE SCHEDULE FOR THE DAY?

- A Period – students will attend as usual
- 8:30 – All seniors report to the football field for the Sr. Class photo
- 9:05 – Board buses for Waterworld
- 2:15 – Board buses for return to SRV (by 2:45P)

2. WILL I NEED EXTRA MONEY AT WATERWORLD?

____/____ I agree NOT to use drugs or alcohol prior to or during the Senior Waterworld Trip. Furthermore, I understand that I am accountable for my own actions. All school rules apply during the trip. Should this agreement be violated, the consequences for San Ramon Valley High School students could be academic suspension and loss of the privilege to attend ALL the remaining school activities through June 10, 2011.
