Students must park the vehicles so the parking sticker is visible from the lot. <u>Only 1 (one) permitted vehicle may park on campus on any given day.</u>	_____	_____
3.	Parking rules will be enforced from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday-Friday.	_____	_____
4.	All vehicles parked on or adjacent to the school campus are subject to search by the administration or a designee.	_____	_____
5.	The parking permit issued is for the vehicle listed on the registration portion of this application. Permits placed on any other vehicle will be void. Do not tape the pass to the window.	_____	_____
6.	If a student must use another vehicle that does not have the parking permit affixed (i.e. vehicle in the repair shop) a temporary parking permit will be provided in the attendance office.
