Students deemed to be College-Ready based on their EAP results are exempt from taking CSU and participating community college placement tests in English and mathematics and move directly into college-level classes upon enrollment.

Students who participate in the EAP must complete the specified CSTs and an additional 15 questions on the English and mathematics portions of the CSTs. Students are also required to complete an essay for the English portion of the EAP.

The EAP results are incorporated into the STAR Student Report. Students who seek or intend to enroll in a CSU or CCC and wish to have their scores released should fill in the bubble in the EAP Readiness for College English and Mathematics – EAP Augmentation sections on their STAR answer sheets. The EAP results can only be released to the CSU or CCC through this process. Please encourage your grade eleven students to release their EAP results. Students who choose not to release their EAP results but later decide that they would like the CSU and/or community colleges to receive their English and mathematics EAP results will be asked to provide the results to CSU or participating community colleges themselves.

County and District Superintendents and Charter School Administrators

We ask for your support in ensuring that your High School Principals and Assistant Principals, College and High School Counselors and Career Center Directors, and grade eleven English and mathematics teachers receive a copy of this letter.

Copies of the letter to grade eleven students are included with this letter for forwarding to your grade eleven English and mathematics teachers to distribute to their grade eleven students. Please indicate to your school staff the importance of distributing the letter to grade eleven students at least two weeks before the CSTs are administered on your high school campus.

College and High School Counselors and Career Center Directors

We ask for your support in ensuring that your grade eleven English and mathematics teachers receive a copy of this letter. Please encourage your English and mathematics teachers to distribute the letter to their grade eleven students at least two weeks before the CSTs are administered on your high school campus.
